Graduation 2020.....A grad like no other

2020 will be a grad unlike any other

Nothing about 2020 has been normal so far with the Covid-19 pandemic changing just about everything. Schools in Saskatchewan have been closed since March 20 due to the pandemic with students having to move to remote learning options.

For the students who are in their final year of secondary school, they've lost a lot of the opportunities most graduating classes that for granted.

There will be no in-person graduation ceremonies this spring to celebrate what students across the province and country have accomplished because it's not yet safe.

Without the ability to properly mark completing a major chapter in their lives, students all over will be having virtual graduations.

McNaughton High School

"We're not allowed to meet with the students so they'll be submitting video to us and we'll be compiling that into a grad ceremony," said McNaughton High School Principal Jeff St. Onge.

"They'll have individual videos sent in to us and we're going to be creating a graduation ceremony with the submitted footage. We'll provide some footage too, with our class speakers, guest speakers, three types of things, and we'll try to make it into the actual ceremony, just in a virtual manner.

"We purchased school personalized USBs that we're going to give each graduate as a gift with the video ceremony uploaded on it," said Vice Principal Sherrie Meredith.

"It's been a skidding scale because initially we had one plan and when that fell apart we had another plan, and we always kind of had a plan to put a video together and we just had to have the footage submitted to us," said St. Onge.

"When we first suggested the idea of a virtual graduation, of course there was disappointment that the traditional grad ceremony wasn't happening, but then this generated some new excitement because it gave the students something to look forward to and mark on their calendars," said Meredith.

"They knew they'd have this USB key given to them so that they could watch and have their own celebration with their family in a small gathering.

"Overall, this was accepted well because they were pleased that they were still going to get something," said St. Onge. "We also made a slideshow of all of our graduates that's running on the billboard at the Sportsplex. It has all the students' photos and graduation messages. That started on the day that they would have had grad — May 23 — and that's running until the end of June."

Esterhazy High School

"Esterhazy High School — along with other high schools in Good Spirit School Division — were advised to have an online virtual grad," said Esterhazy High School teacher and grad advisor Shayna Zubko. "It has been challenging to plan for this scenario, but the three grad advisors as well as our administrators have worked to come up with a feasible plan.

"On June 26 we will be holding an online 'Honouring of the Class of 2020' via Zoom. Links will be shared with the family shortly before the event. Although the event has similar elements to a regular graduation ceremony at EHS, it is functioning as a celebration for now, until we can have an in-person event in the future.

"When the graduates and their families were polled by the school division, there was a consensus that a face-to-face graduation ceremony would be preferred," she said. "The staff of EHS agree that the graduates of 2020 deserve celebrations and acknowledgement as much as any previous or future grad classes.

"In addition to the online honouring of the graduates, the grad advisors petitioned the town to have the gradu-

ation pictures and names on the digital town sign that sits by the museum. Those pictures will be there in June."

Maryfield High School

"The class of 2020 will experience an unprecedented virtual grad ceremony this year," said Maryfield High School Principal Pamela Stephens. "The digital display will combine speeches, toasts, and photographs/videos.

"The traditional slideshow which shares a student's journey from baby stages to graduation will be included along with a voice over introduction of each graduate. It is our hope that as each family holds individual grad celebrations with family and friends, photos will be shared and can be included in the virtual keepsake.

"Awards are still being honoured and honourees will be displayed in the presentation and in the media," she said. SCC grad gifts are being presented to grads and students are privately sharing parent/guardian gifts as well. We are looking into placing gift/card boxes at a location in the community so that others may share their joy.

"As a school, we have purchased yard signs for the graduates — these will be displayed in the month of June so stay tuned for the unveiling of these lovely tributes and student keepsakes.

"It is our hope that the class of 2020 would be welcomed back next year and become honoured guests at the banquet," she said. "In these challenging times, we are doing our best to honour our graduates and be there for them as they move through this amazing rite of passage."

Whitewood High School

"We put this to a vote with our graduates and families and the majority wanted to wait until fall to have their grad, in the hopes that they could be 'in the same room' receiving their diplomas," said Whitewood High School Principal Brenda Doud.

"So our grad is postponed and our date is set for September 12 at 3 p.m. We are going to try and have as 'normal' a grad as we can, depending on the circumstances at the time.

"If we can't have a normal ceremony, it will be done virtually, where there will be little to no contact," she said. "The date will not change or get pushed back further, it will be what it will be on September 12. Meanwhile, large pictures have been put up downtown by the parents of the grads and we have included pictures of them on our school's sign to celebrate right now."

Redvers High School

"We're following the guidelines given to us by the chief medical officer and our division has put things in place as well," said Redvers High School teacher/grad advisor Chylisse Marchand. "Our hands are tied to really having anything open to the public."

"In working with the students and the parents, we're pretty much doing the only thing we can do, which is a virtual grad. All of the students got signs outside the building, so the kids are acknowledged that way. On our Facebook page I made an individual shoutout for each student using their plans for the upcoming year. The virtual grad will pretty much be the same thing as the ceremony using photos, voiceovers, Adobe Premier, and announcing awards and everything like that. It's pretty much all virtual. I'm going to be saving the video on a USB stick for all of the students. Each family is going to get a USB of the video, that way they can share it with whomever they want.

"It's been tough," she said. "There are people who are quite supportive and understand where we're at. It's been tricky, but I have quite a few parents who are beyond appreciative with the work I've put into it. There's so much out of our control and we're just doing the best we can. My heart's broken for these kids too so I'm doing everything I possibly can to make sure they

get their day."

Viriden Collegiate Institute

"We've got a little green spot in our front entrance way to our school," said Viriden Collegiate Institute Principal Mark Keown. "What we're going to do is have a slotted drive up type of approach to that spot. Grads will pull up with their families, jump out, come up a little red carpet, get a presentation in front of our building outside — as long as weather permits, otherwise we'll slide into our gym to do that.

"Each grad will come up through during their slot, they'll have whatever time that takes probably 10 to 15 minutes. That will be happening from 10 a.m. until 4 p.m. throughout the day and then we're kind of congregating back to see if we can have a little bit of a cruise around town a little later.

"We're still waiting on final approval for the cruise," he said. "But the plan is to have a little bit of a cruise where the grads line up and drive through town to let everybody see the kids going through the process.

"That looks like the extent, just because of our numbers with 72 grads. It's tough to meet the regulations of a maximum of 50 in an outdoor setting to pull that off. We talked through lots of other options, but this was the one that logically meets the requirements and is doable.

"We're appreciative of the school division," he said. "The superintendent was adamant that he wanted to have something done in June. With delaying it to the fall, you just don't know if we'll be in an any better state or if people will be able to come back. We're pretty happy to just have something."

Elkhorn High School

"We have an indoor and an outdoor plan, because if the weather gets nasty we'll have to move indoors," said Elkhorn High School Principal Lance Barrate. "As of right now, we're allowed 50 for an outdoor ceremony. We're looking at doing our outdoor ceremony at Elkhorn Memorial Park on June 20.

"Normally we do the grad ceremony our gym and there's probably about 350 people between grads, families, friends, community members, presenters, and staff. Usually we have considerably more people, but we're restricted right now to 50 outdoors — if the weather is bad and we have to go indoor then we can only have 25 and that will be at the rink.

"There's enough room there (Elkhorn Memorial Park) to follow all the rules," he said. "You're also allowed to have some vehicles pulled up on the periphery of the actual contained ceremony area. We'll probably have some grandparents and other people in their vehicles.

"The company that's doing sound for it will also be doing video and live streaming it. People who aren't at the park or in their vehicles who want to watch what's going on it still can.

"It's definitely not ideal, but I think at the end of the day it will be as reasonably close as we can get it to someone normal and because we don't have a huge graduating class, we have a lot more options."

Rocanville High School

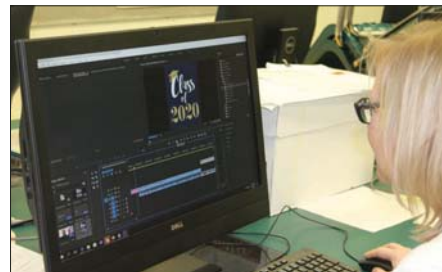
"It's going to be a virtual grad," said grad advisor Karen Crawford. "It'll kind of be like their regular ceremony. They'll have a valedictorian, speeches, awards, a toast to the parents, teachers will speak, and we have someone filming it. Then on June 26 there will be a parade in the evening.

"They're talking about the kids using golf carts or their own vehicles and driving through town that night to celebrate them. Then we'll also have grad banners put up around town as soon as they're made. They'll be going up around main street."

Students have also been able to continue to participate in grad planning through Microsoft Teams with Mrs. Gibson and Mrs. Matichuk. They let us know music selections, themes, and give input as to what they would like included in their virtual grad ceremony.

We have asked grads to submit their footage to us by mid-June and we will begin the editing process to be completed by the end of the month for their viewing pleasure.
